Martin Luther, renewer of the church, died 1546.

On this day, in 1546, Martin Luther died at the age of 62. For a time, he was an Augustinian monk, but it is his work as a biblical scholar, translator of the Bible, public confessor of the faith, reformer of the liturgy, theologian, educator, and father of German vernacular literature that holds him in our remembrance. In Luther's own judgment, the greatest of all of his work was his catechism, written to instruct people in the basics of faith. And it was his baptism that sustained him in his trials as a reformer.
